

Education grants funding Criteria:

- Must reside within the Parish of St Dennis or within the St Dennis & Nanpean Electoral Division.
- Proof of residence will be required for all applications.
- Is open to all individuals over the age of 11. Under 11 years of age may be considered in extenuating circumstances.
- Applicants will still be considered if they are living outside of the electoral division as a result of pursuing a course of education.
- For Higher education and adult learning must have confirmation that a placement has been agreed, be enrolled on or already attending a course.
- For apprenticeships it must be shown that an apprenticeship has been awarded.
- All grants awarded must be used for the purchase of new equipment only.
- Applications for any form of driving license will not be considered.

To Be utilised for:

- Fees for tuition or education.
- Proven expenses incurred in relation to the pursuit of education or tuition including but not limited to: living costs, technological assistance for education purposes, transport, resources, registered childcare or apprenticeship tools.

Limitations:

- Capped limits as agreed for Camera equipment at GSCE level, standard laptops, printers and software, which is not supplied by the education provider.
- Amount limited to £3000 per applicant over 5 years
- University students limited to £5,000 over 5 years.
- Applications must be for individuals only
- Any grant approved will be subject to the signing of the terms and conditions before payment can be made.
- The applicant must indicate acceptance of such conditions when any offer of a grant is made.

Capped Limits:

The Committee have set limits set for specific items as follows:

- £300 towards laptops for standard applications.
- £100 towards software which is not supplied by the education provider.
- £50 towards printer.
- £150 towards camera equipment at GCSE level.
