

Clerks Report for Dec 2024

Playing Field:

- The lower area behind the playing field fence has been strimmed.
- Tree planting event has been undertaken to replace some of the trees that had to be removed due to ash die back.
- Remote access to the CCTV system has been ordered.

Cemetery:
